HAPPY SUMMER!

Happy summer everyone!

Can you believe it is already July? Time flies when the warm weather hits Toronto. We are excited to catch up with you! There has been some very new and exciting announcements recently....let's start with Toronto's new MAYOR!

Congratulations to Olivia Chow for making history. Olivia Chow is the first Chinese-Canadian mayor of Toronto, and the first female mayor following amalgamation. Hours after being elected Mayor, Olivia Chow stated that her first order of business will be to focus on affordable housing.

We know first hand the impact of our worsening housing crisis, leaving many individuals and families unsheltered and in unsafe circumstances. Olivia Chow has vowed to build 25,000 rent-controlled homes over the next 8 years on city owned land.

Olivia Chow has opted for greater advocacy for renters. She aims to establish a renters action committee composed of city staff, renters, housing providers, and advocates. The hope would be real rent control, double the reach of Toronto's rent bank, and triple the reach of eviction prevention. The goal will also be to create a secure affordable homes fund, which would be used to transfer and purchase affordable rental stock to notfor-profit housing providers. Furthermore, there are plans to create 1,000 new rent supplements to help secure permanent housing, open new 24 hour respite spaces, and establish a fund for new services to support the current homelessness emergency in Toronto.

HOTT houses some of Toronto's most vulnerable households. 88% of HOTT's portfolio is comprised of households paying below market rent. It is HOTT's mission to provide quality, affordable housing. We are delighted that it is now also Toronto's mission with the support of our new mayor Olivia Chow.
