🎆 New Year, New Home on Roncesvalles!

We're starting the year strong! HOTT is thrilled to welcome our 15th property to the portfolio — a beautiful new building on Roncesvalles Avenue, made possible through the City of Toronto's MURA program.

This acquisition adds 38 new homes, bringing our total to 209 affordable and deeply affordable units across Toronto. It also marks another exciting step west, expanding our reach into a vibrant new neighbourhood and strengthening our long-term impact.

While we're incredibly proud of this milestone, it's important to share that this acquisition was not an easy process. Securing the necessary financing — particularly additional mortgage funding — was complex and required persistence, creativity, and the support of many partners. From start to finish, it took over 10 months to successfully secure this property. This reality underscores just how critical flexible funding, donor support, and community investment are to making projects like this possible.

As HOTT continues to grow, our commitment remains the same: building sustainable, inclusive communities.

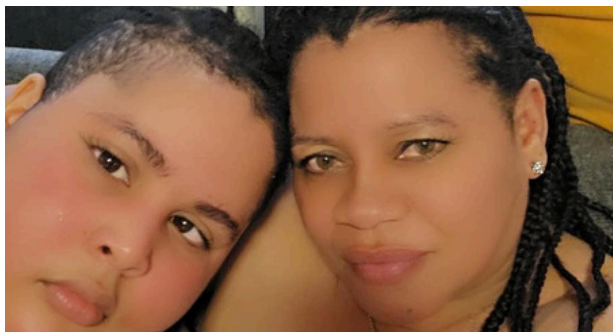
